A practical accessory for easy transport and space-saving storage.





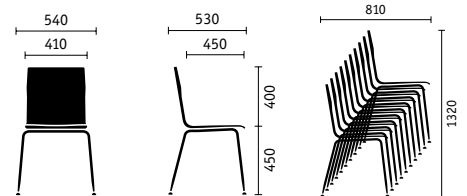
For outstanding ideas.

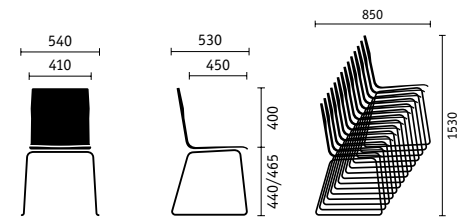

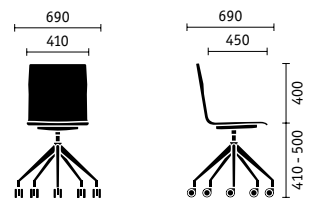

Comfortable. meet chair visitor and swivel chairs are available in natural-looking wood or plastic shell. For the wood version, seat and backrest upholstery are available to choose from on request. The frames are made of chrome-plated steel. The four-leg version is stackable up to 10 units, and the skid version up to 14 units. Both variants can be optionally connected in rows.

The swivel chair is available on request with easy to use height adjustment. The plastic star base is available in black and clear white.

Plastics. For the one-piece – flexible plastic seat shell produced with the monosandwich technology – there are five colours to choose from.

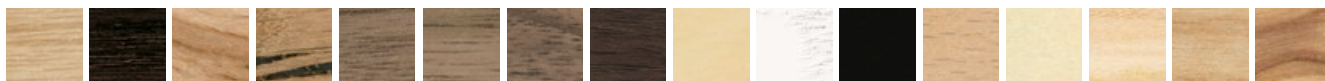
